FRAMEWORK: European Union (EU) Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) Risk Mitigation Centres of Excellence (CoE) Initiative. Funded by the European Union and jointly implemented by the EU and the United Nations Interregional Crime and Justice Research Institute (UNICRI).

OVERALL GOAL: Strengthen capabilities of Partner Countries to mitigate CBRN risks, whether natural, accidental, or deliberate in origin.

National Focal Points (NFPs): Lead CBRN CoE activities at the countrylevel, participate in regional and international Round-Table Meetings and liaise with the Regional Secretariat and relevant regional and international partners. All 28 Partner Countries have appointed NFPs.



National Teams (NTs): Inter-agency teams that identify national priorities for capacity-building, participate in CBRN CoE projects and work towards the establishment of comprehensive and integrated national CBRN risk mitigation policies. All Partner Countries established National Teams.



National Action Plans (NAPs): Identify strategic priority actions for capacitybuilding, to support resource allocation.
