#### CONTEXT

The Mediterranean region and the Black Sea region are close neighbours of the European Union and are particularly exposed to health risks (epidemic, pandemic) and disasters (man-made or natural) which can have a serious impact on populations, resources and infrastructures and could undermine the region's efforts for sustainable development.

# **OVERALL OBJECTIVE**

To enhance health security in the Mediterranean and Black Sea regions by supporting capacity-building for prevention and control of biological, natural, or man-made health threats through the further roll-out of a sustainable training programme in intervention epidemiology.

# **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- 1. Training a regional cadre of field epidemiologists;
- 2. Training national trainers and supervisors and provide support to cascade trainings;
- Disseminate experience, knowledge and skills among non-EU countries, EU partners and other key actors in the field; fostering synergies between MediPIET and other FETPs;
- Engaging partner countries for bigger impact, and incorporating national and regional public health priorities to the programme curriculum.
