Recent Achievements

Collaboration amongst partner countries of the region and within the larger CoE CBRN Initiative by attending annual international events within the CoE CBRN Network: CBRN Academies, National Focal Points Days as well as Heads of Secretariat to elaborate strategies to counter emerging risks ranging from CBRN terrorism to disinformation.

Cooperation is reinforced with the African Union and the League of Arab States to jointly address CBRN risks and find synergies to respond to them.

Coordination mechanisms are established with **key stakeholders** at international, regional, and national levels, as well as with other donors and initiatives. These include the IAEA, BWC-ISU, OPCW, UNSC 1540 Committee, UNEP, UNDP, UN Country Teams, EU Delegations, embassies, and others.
